



























Sands Murray-Wassink (b. 1974, Topeka, Kansas) is a queer cult figure within Amsterdam's art scene for nearly three decades since he moved here in 1994 to attend De Ateliers. The Dutch-American artist is a painter, body artist, writer, and perfume collector whose work draws deeply from intersectional feminist and queer art traditions. Influences such as Carolee Schneemann. Hannah Wilke. and Adrian Piper serve as foundational coordinates for his practice. While Murray-Wassink has oscillated between periods of institutional visibility and guieter phases of production, his body of work has continually expanded, encompassing a wide range of art and non-art objects.

In the last decade the figure of Sands has re-emerged into the Amsterdam and international scene, mostly thanks to the attention paid by younger artists who are not only fans but also collectors of his works such as Nora Turato, Özgür Kar, Kate Cooper or Evelyn Taocheng Wang.

In 2021 he completed a two year residency at the Rijksakademie, being the only artist who has completed residencies at both De Ateliers and the Rijksakademie. Recently solo shows happened in Auto Italia, London in 2022, Le Confort Moderne, Poitiers in 2023, Frieze London, London in 2024 and diez, Amsterdam in 2025.

Murray-Wassink's work is part of the collection of Museo Nacional Centro de Arte Reina Sofia in Madrid, CA2M in Madrid and Stedelijk Museum in Amsterdam among different private collections. He got awarded with the Jeanne Oosting Prijs in 2023.
