


This group of works revolve around perceptions of the same person. To latch on to their traits through painting, to extract them and compose with them, is to seek something anonymous in the face of a friend.


Deshaun Price, Untitled, 2025 Oil on canvas 162 x 130 cm I 64 x 51 in PRC/2








Deshaun Price, Study for Standing Figure, 2025 Oil on canvas 46 x 38 cm l 18 x 15 in PRC/4
