‘Gruel (guzzler reheated)’

Gruel was a series of exhibitions by the residents of Guzzler, a gallery in Rosanna, Victoria, Australia that ran from 2019 until 2023. These exhibitions had no defined theme, but the word ‘gruel’ can be defined as ‘porridge’, ‘punishment’ or ‘something that lacks substance or significance.’ Gruel is barely nutritional starvation food, one that allows the body to continue to function (per- or subsist) while not to flourish — its consumer scarcely kept alive until next meal. Relocated from Rosanna to Cologne, in this latest serving the scraps of Gruel and its makers are reheated once more.
