About the Artist

Richard Sides' works are time-based, expanded collages that combine a variety of media to generate environments that explore notions of agency, morality and affect within systems of contemporary media. Improvisation and site-specificity are key elements of his practice that often engage architecture with video as a central narrative tool.

His multifaceted output in video, installation, sound, performance and collage blurs seamlessly allowing characters and abstract notions of consciousness to emerge from the complex social composite environments he creates in his work. – Anna Gritz, Cura Magazine, 2014

Major presentations of Sides' work have been staged at Kunstverein Braunschweig (2019), Kunstverein Hannover (2021) & Museum Angewandte Kunst, Frankfurt am Main (2020) as recipient of the Ars Viva Award; Carlos/Ishikawa, London (2025); amongst others.

Collaboration and self-organisation also play a part in Sides' practice – he often makes work with other people or produces events and exhibitions. He has organised institutional exhibitions internationally; e.g. in 2021 he worked on the two-part video exhibition *Tourism*, curated with Judith Welter and Luca Beeler, Kunsthaus Glarus & Stadtgalerie Bern. Ongoing activities include the collaborative project *The Wig*; publishing music and digital media projects through his *BUS project*; Sides coorganised *The Woodmill* (2009 – 2014), an artist-run studio and gallery in South London; writes music and worked on the project *Sound Spill* – an examination of how sound inhabits exhibition spaces and interacts within.
