

**Elisabeth Molin** and **Kate V Robertson** each have a unique relationship to sculptural forms. Emerging from photography, Molin's artworks invite total body engagement. For Robertson sculpture acts as a lens, allowing her to cast associative connotations. At first glance this two person exhibition features a range of traditionally sculptural forms, bronzes on plinths, compartmental installation and wall reliefs. Thinking beyond those formal associations, **s\_c\_u\_l\_p\_t\_u\_r\_e** embraces pictorial depth and the potential of juxtaposition to underscore the expanded dimension of sculpture in our increasingly screen-based world.
