I supply the reel and let it run, casually running my fingers along the film as it spins, coiling like a snake on the platter. Thousands of images loop through the machinery, picking up speed and becoming one fluid stream of frames per second—rotation is the image's fundamental motion. I neatly, deftly perform the final adjustments of my equipment, smiling at the quality of my own work, whispering to myself: framing, check; focus, check; sound, check. I'm creating pathways from perception to processing; I'm in control of the image-making object; *I'm on my mad scientist shit right now*.

You can always hear the image before you can see it: the tinny whirring, clicking and buzzing as teeth sink into sprocket holes and gears spin around and around and around and—you get the idea. Hollywood Executives are waging a war on my symphony but, like I've always said: everything is about customer satisfaction. What they want is the unimaginable universe, the appearance of a world before the world in 4K. What they want is: an impossible perspective, a dimensional shift. Or: to see everything at eye-level. They want to be transported to another world and think, smugly, that the photography was striking but the plot really fell apart in the third act.

Once, listening to some fancy professor talk about projectors, I misheard lens for limbs. I confused the body with the machine. I imagined my neck extending into a technocrane, my wide-angle over the city, my bird's eye view descending into a close-up. The image-making object becomes the object-making image, conjuring up a third dimension through the confluence of two, separate and distinct perspectives. It's all about perception. It's like I said: before the image was an image it was a trick of the mind.
