

Beau Travail is pleased to present Skulptur Projekte 2.0. Over 35 artists have been invited to present their work in the gallery's outdoor garden. Photographs have been posed as sculptures. The gallery's door has been transformed into a freestanding work for sale. A jawbreaker candy has been placed in a steel flower, changing colors over the course of the Swedish coolocation summer with its high chances of rain. On the garden table, bottles have been glued together with sand inside them; each measuring 10 mins if one dares to turn them over. Balls made of aluminum foil are stuffed into the door of the so called pigsty. A handy ramp has been constructed for those who need it, finally making the gallery's entrance wheelchair accessible. An artist and his family members will enjoy a meal as a living, breathing adaptation of Manet's Luncheon on the grass. A sexy ass growing out of the garden and a welded face that goes "Shh.."
