Worklist:

Deals (2025)

A set of temporary structures built for the exhibition. The institution commits to later store and reuse it when convenient.

T. (2025)

One device indicating the temperature of the space.

One (2024)

The only licensed radio station from the artist's hometown broadcasted in the space.

Privacy (2023)

A set of curtains loaned from the artist's family members.

RENTAL/FATHER (2023)

One or more objects rented from the artist's father.

Picks (2022)

A set of flowers, branches and bushes picked by the artist. Location: Thierschstraße / Thierschplatz, 80538 München

Field (2021)

The longest wall of the exhibition space marked with the indication of its length, and a wall perpendicular to it marked with the length to complete the area of one acre, as specified by the artist. The marks should be made at the average height of a commercial ox.
