
















Self's new paintings speak to the artist's recent investigations into repetition, pattern, and abstraction as they relate to both the individual and the collective subconscious. She constructs depictions of predominantly women using a combination of sewn, printed, and painted materials, traversing different artistic and craft traditions. The formal and conceptual aspects of Self's work seek to expand her critical inquiry into selfhood and human flourishing.


