Titled Kissing The Shuttle, the show consists of mouth-blown glass sculptures hung from wooden pegs, ISSUES paintings inspired by schematic instructions on how to assemble ISSUES **ISSUES** a loom, and a group of paintings resembling faces made from (painted) buttons and spools of thread. "Kissing the shuttle" is a **ISSUES** term used in the late 19th century, to describe a process by which **ISSUES** weavers in the textile factories used their mouths to pull thread **ISSUES** through the eye of a shuttle . The same shuttles were used by many $\ensuremath{\mathsf{S}}$ **ISSUES** weavers and the women in the factories were accused of spreading **ISSUES** disease by "kissing the shuttle".
