







This illuminated footbath serves as a place of respite, to calm the mind, a sort of mental charging station. It contains my *Occiolini* Lens Glasses, which draw upon my earlier paintings, *Blocked Radiants* from 2011. In that series, I aimed to depict phenomena that are invisible or transparent, such as heat, sweat or radiation and which refer to a living organism such as fauna, fishbones, feathers and foliage. Engaged with the metaphysical strands of abstraction, I took the astronomical suns from these paintings and translated them into stained glass.
