When Erich Heimhilcher received his diagnosis at the age of 21, they told him he didn’t have long to live. 42 years later he decided to die and chose *Last Date* by Duane Eddy as his final song. It was the jingle of a radio programme he used to secretly listen to as a teenager when he was supposed to be asleep already.

In the 1960s, a Tastee-Freez was built in Guelph. It closed down in the 70s and stood vacant for years. More recently the building housed various used car dealerships and in 2024 Danan Lake started to organise exhibitions there. After this show it will cease to exist. What will come after is still unclear.
