PLAY IT AGAIN BUDD !

This is the name of the current exhibition showing at A R T S P A C E until 26 May 1995. Lillian Budd is one of the pseudonyms of the New Zealand artist Merylyn Tweedie who is one of New Zealand's leading contemporary artists included in the secondary school arts curriculum.

George Hubbard is a independent curator. In this show, George has taken on the role traditionally played by the artist in the gallery, selecting and directing the style of the installation.

The exhibition comprises of four very large wall works and a couple of smaller installation works, as well as a sound track composed by Christchurch artist, Paul Sutherland, composing under the pseudonym, P Void.

The exhibition raises issues of authorship and the artist / audience relationship as well as exploring definitions of art. Text and conversation are strong motifs within the display.

We encourage you to bring your students to A R T S P A C E to see the show. One of our staff will be available to answer questions about the work during the exhibition. Although it is not necessary to do so, it would be helpful to us if you let us know if you are coming to visit.

Also in the gallery is an Installation by Swiss artist Ian Anüll who has exhibited widely internationally. Both Budd Special Projects Division and Anüll exhibited in March at CBD gallery, Sydney this year. This Installation has been facilitated by Stephen Bambury.
