Hoang deftly evokes the spirit of the natural world in verdant compositions that dance between abstractions of time, memory, and tangible phenomena, like weather and place.

*Garden Poems* is a series of small oil paintings that come out of taking a moment to make more intimate observations of nature; of gardens, of flowers, of the changing seasons. My garden memories are the catalyst to explore color, composition, and marks - colorful blooms, lush leaves, seed pods and stems; as we wait for Spring, for the birds to sing and the sun to warm the soil, so new growth can begin again".
