Chris Lipomi (b. 1975) lives and works in Los Angeles, CA. He was educated at UCLA; Valand Kunstkolan, Goteborg, Sweden; The San Francisco Art Institute, and the Skowhegan School of Painting and Sculpture. He has received the Edward J. and Alice Mae Smith Award (2003); the Lillian Levinson Scholarship Award (2002); and the Paul Sack Award for Photography (1999).
