Moyra Davey's exhibition *Long Life Cool White* opens, to your right, with a work called *Copperheads*. Its one hundred photographs arranged in a grid look like poisonous landscapes, aerial views of strip mines, or shots of the surface of the moon. Upon closer inspection, however, you may begin to discern the profile of Abraham Lincoln as it appears on the American penny. *Copperheads* offers the pleasure of that surprise, as well as a feeling of amazement at the debased, banal, and sometimes vaguely fecal characteristics of the depicted coins. In many ways, *Copperheads* establishes a set of working terms for Davey's oeuvre: a close attention to detail, in which the eye is trained on what is conventionally overlooked, combined with the precision that photography can offer (the enlargement of the macro lens and the ability to arrest time) and a sensitivity to psychological themes embedded in everyday objects.

Davey consistently works at a modest scale, and her subject matter is commensurate with this humbleness: still lifes, pictures of dust, and images of the outmoded, such as record albums and hi-fi equipment, recur frequently. Both her banal street scenes—the disappearing world of newspaper vendors in New York City, an old button shop—and her domestic interiors—pictures of her dog, objects on top of the refrigerator, books on shelves—suggest a

steady but subtle insistence on the private realm and all of its antimonumental vicissitudes. While her photographs channel classic photographers as disparate as Eugène Atget, Jacques-André Boiffard, and Walker Evans, her interests have produced a body of work in a minor key, a series of images of things as rooted in daily life as they are precariously at the edge of it.




