18. (A defenceless man consumes a meal in silence) / And what you own
19. Sometimes I can't sleep for thinking / is what you do not own
20. Of all the things you should have said / And where you are
21. This consummate sadness / of old men eating / is where you are not.
22. Nuns / On / Main / Laugh / On / Tain / Time present and time past / Are both perhaps present in time future.
